This half term our topic is '**Magical Kingdoms**', which is to inspire the children as creative writers and artists.

Over this half term, the children will be developing their Literacy and I.C.T. skills by researching, writing and presenting what they have found out.

To support their learning we would like the children to choose at least **two** of the ideas from sections A,B & C below, so that by the end of the half term, they should have completed at least two homework activities. They can choose what they do and how they present it, but we are looking for creative and imaginative work!

In addition to this we would like them to complete **all** maths activities.

Write a fact sheet about dragons.  Write about which magical power you would like and why.  Write a magic poem.	A picture/collage of their favourite magical creature.  Make a small 3D model of a magical kingdom.  Make something using Purple Mash Paint Projects: to make a magical creature.	Find out about the different characters in magical stories.  Find out about a magic trick to share.  Find out about a famous dragon. Do dragons still exist?	Learn 2,5,10 times tables multiplication and division off by heart.  Revise number stories for all numbers up to 20. Eg. Story of 5 0+5=5 1+4=5 2+3=5 3+2=5 4+1=5 5+0=5 5-0=5 5-1=4 etc.

If the children complete anything on the computer, for example a PowerPoint or video clips, please bring in on a memory stick or CD, we will return it.
