Parking

We are all aware that parking in the area of Cheddar First School is extremely limited and this causes problems for parents, staff and visitors. The local PCSOs are working extremely hard to try and ensure safe and legal parking on The Hayes, however this has led to problems elsewhere including the staff car park.

A small number of parents are regularly using the staff car park to pick up and drop off their children. Please can I remind you that the only parents that should be using the car park between 8:30am and 4:00pm are parents of children with disabilities and that the disabled spaces must be left free for people with disabilities at all times. In exceptional circumstances permission may be given to families to use the car park on a temporary basis following injuries or surgery.

These regulations are necessary for Health and Safety and Insurance reasons. Health and Safety regulations require that pedestrian and vehicle traffic are not mixed and this happens when children are crossing the car park. The number of cars would also make it impossible for the emergency services to get onto the site.

To try and ensure the safe use of the car park we will be shutting the main gates. Parents with permission to park can open & close the gates and we apologise for the inconvenience this inevitably causes, but feel it is the only way we can regulate the traffic. If you do still park in the staff carpark, please do not be offended if you are asked to move. Thank you for your understanding and co-operation.
