Bristol Zoo Project - Tuesday 22nd April

Dear Parents & Guardians,

We are excited to be visiting The Bristol Zoo Project (formerly The Wild Place) in Bristol on Tuesday 22nd April 2025 as part of next term's topic entitled 'Creep, Crawl and Wriggle'. The children will have an opportunity to look around the site, take part in a mini beast workshop and have a picnic!

The children will need to wear their school uniform and take a coat. If the weather is sunny they will also need a sunhat and be wearing sun cream. We will be leaving school at 9am (approx.) and be back in school by 3:30 pm. Due to such a prompt departure time, please ensure that your child is in class before this.

As children in Reception are entitled to universal free school meals, there is the option of a packed lunch in place of a hot dinner. Lists will be put up in the classrooms where you can choose between a ham, cheese or tuna mayo sandwich which comes with fruit and a drink. Alternatively, you can select to provide your own packed lunch from home. Please ensure you make your choices on the classroom lists that should be up in the classrooms during the first week of term.

If you wish to provide your child with a packed lunch, please bring this in a disposable bag so that this can be thrown away afterwards.

We are kindly asking for a voluntary contribution of £21 towards the cost of the coach, entrance fee and activities. We do not expect families in receipt of Income Support to contribute if they are not able to do so and no pupil will be excluded from the activity if their parents decide not to contribute. However, we may have to cancel this activity if we do not receive enough contributions.

If you agree to your child taking part in this trip, please give your consent on ParentPay, together with your contribution of £21. Please note - even if you are unable to contribute to this activity, you will still need to consent to this trip on ParentPay for your child to attend.

We are also looking for volunteers to come along on this trip - if you can help out with this, please let us know.
