We are delighted to confirm the details for this year's residential visit for our Year 3 children. This year, we will be staying at the Mendip Activity Centre in Churchill for a two-day trip with one overnight stay. The trip will take place on the following dates:

- **Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 6<sup>th</sup> June** – Kestrel and some of Owl Class

7:30pm: Evening activity (could include a night walk or bonfire on site)

### Day 2:

8:30am: Hot breakfast (cereals, toast, etc.)

9:30am - 12:30pm: Activity session

12:45pm: Hot lunch

1:30pm: Departure

We are pleased to inform you that the cost of this trip has been kindly subsidised by the Mendip Activity Centre, making the cost £75 per child. You may pay this in one lump sum or in instalments. However, we kindly request a deposit of £25 by **Friday 28th March** with full payment due by **Friday 23rd May 2025**. If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium Funding, the cost of the trip will be further subsidised, and this will already be applied to your ParentPay account.

We will be sending out a kit list and medical information forms closer to the date of the trip. Additionally, we will be holding an information evening where you will have the opportunity to learn more about the Mendip Activity Centre and the activities your child will be participating in.
